RECENT CHANGES

LSAC will administer the LSAT both as a remotely proctored test and in Prometric test centers. The test format and content will be the same regardless of where students choose to take the LSAT.

As of August 2021, LSAC includes an unscored, unidentified experimental section along with the three scored sections.

Beginning in August 2024, the LSAT will have two scored Logical Reasoning sections, one scored Reading Comprehension section, and one unscored and unidentified experimental Logical Reasoning or Reading Comprehension section. The LSAT will no longer include an Analytical Reasoning (Logic Games) section. No new question types or test content will be added to the new LSAT.

CANCELLATIONS

If you need to cancel your scores after consulting with your tutor, cancellation requests must be submitted online by 11:59 p.m. (ET) the sixth day after your LSAT. Your score report *will* indicate that you canceled your score.

All test takers (not just first-time test takers) have the option to purchase Score Preview, which allows students to preview their scores before deciding whether to keep them. Students who purchase this option will receive their scores at the same time as other test takers (as long as they have an LSAT Writing sample on file) and then have six days to decide whether to cancel or keep their scores.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Students must register for the LSAT before requesting accommodations. The application required for accommodated testing (including all documentation) is due by the registration deadline, but LSAC strongly encourages students to have all information submitted earlier.

If you wish to take the LSAT again or transfer your registration to another date, you must submit another written request for accommodations by the deadline associated with your registration for an administration of the LSAT.
